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Investment Objective and Strategy

The fundamental investment objective of **First Trust Indxx Innovative Transaction and Process ETF** (the “First Trust ETF”) is to replicate, to the extent possible, the performance of an innovative transaction and process index. Currently, the First Trust ETF seeks to replicate, to the extent possible, the performance of the Indxx Blockchain Index (the “Index”), provided by Indxx, LLC, net of expenses.

The investment strategy of the First Trust ETF is to obtain exposure to the Index by holding shares of a U.S.-listed index ETF, the First Trust Indxx Innovative Transaction & Process ETF (the “Underlying Fund”), which replicates or substantially replicates the performance of the Index by directly holding the Constituent Securities of the Index. The First Trust ETF may also hold cash and cash equivalents or other money market instruments to fund current liabilities. The Index seeks to track the performance of exchange-listed common shares (or corresponding ADRs or GDRs) of companies in various industries with their primary listing in developed or emerging market countries that are actively using, investing in, developing or have products that are poised to benefit from blockchain technology and/or the potential for increased efficiency that it provides to various business processes. The Index seeks to include only companies that have devoted material resources to the use of blockchain technologies. However, the Index may contain securities of issuers whose primary business operations are not blockchain related or do not include blockchain related activities.

Risk

The risks associated with an investment in the First Trust ETF remain as discussed in the First Trust ETF’s most recent prospectus. There have been no significant changes during the reporting period that affected the overall level of risk associated with the First Trust ETF.

Results of Operations

General

The First Trust ETF’s net asset value as of December 31, 2022 was \$1,974,966 or \$23.23 per unit. The First Trust ETF’s net asset value as of December 31, 2021 was \$2,924,176 or \$27.85 per unit.

For the year ended December 31, 2022, the First Trust ETF paid total cash distributions of \$0.6693. In addition, the First Trust ETF declared cash distributions per unit of \$0.2813 for record date of December 30, 2022 with payment date of January 9, 2023.

Investment Performance

For the year ended December 31, 2022, the First Trust ETF returned -13.89% compared to the S&P 500® Index (the “benchmark”) total return of -12.16%. Unlike the benchmark, the First Trust ETF’s return is net of fees and expenses.

The First Trust ETF’s only holding, the Underlying Fund, held 101 equity securities as of December 31, 2022. The top ten equity holdings for the Underlying Fund accounted for 14.14% of the portfolio within the Underlying Fund.

The Underlying Fund slightly underperformed the benchmark during the year primarily due to underweight allocations to Health Care and Energy. Currency effects also contributed to the underperformance as the U.S. dollar appreciated significantly relative to leading global currencies during the year. The Underlying Fund was relatively less exposed to U.S. companies than the benchmark. The underperformance was mitigated by stock selection within Communication Services and Financials.

The Underlying Fund’s top five stocks by contribution to return were Lockheed Martin Corporation, ICICI Bank Limited, BHP Group Limited, Mitsubishi UFJ Financial Group, Inc., and Axis Bank Limited. The bottom five stocks by contribution to return were Public Joint Stock Company Gazprom, Sberbank of Russia, Advanced Micro Devices, Inc., PayPal Holdings, Inc., and Wipro Limited.

The First Trust’s ETF’s exposure to the U.S. dollar contributed positively to its absolute performance during the year as the U.S. dollar appreciated 6.96% against the Canadian dollar from December 31, 2021 to December 31, 2022.

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Recent Developments

Since early 2018, the First Trust ETF has given investors exposure to companies involved in the blockchain ecosystem, primarily in the Financials and Information Technology sectors. 2022 has seen a continuation of the stair-stepping downtrend in cryptocurrency prices that began in the fourth quarter of 2021. The so called "Crypto Winter" came with a wipeout of over \$2 trillion of cryptocurrencies as several stablecoins such as TerraUSD imploded and vulnerable DeFi firms such as Celsius faced bankruptcy. November's collapse of FTX served to further the speculative attitude toward the blockchain ecosystem. Cryptocurrencies are typically treated as risky assets and tend to experience deep selloffs along with high-multiple growth stocks. Non-fungible tokens (NFTs) have lost popularity as well. Their trade volumes in December – while up for the first time in eight months – were reported to be down about 80% since last December as many enthusiasts have abandoned digital collectibles. Although retail interest in cryptocurrency and NFTs has waned, enterprises continue to see potential for distributed ledger technology including use cases in smart contracts, digital personal identity, supply chain logistics, and settlement infrastructure. In the event of a recession and crypto winter that eliminates both companies and use cases that are seen to be the least proven to add value, it is likely that only the best capitalized, most resilient business models that adopt essential blockchain applications will emerge on the other side.

Related Party Transactions

FT Portfolios Canada Co. is the Manager of the First Trust ETF and is a Canadian affiliate of First Trust Advisors L.P., the investment advisor (the "Advisor") of the First Trust ETF.

Pursuant to terms of the declaration of trust of the First Trust ETF, the Manager provides or arranges for all management, administrative and other services required by the First Trust ETF. The Manager receives a management fee from the First Trust ETF. For further details, please see "Management Fees".

The Manager has retained the Advisor to provide certain services to the First Trust ETF pursuant to an investment advisory agreement. The Advisor receives advisory fees from the Manager out of the management fee.

(2) Net asset value and distributions are based on the actual number of units outstanding at the relevant time. The increase/decrease from operations is based on the weighted average number of units outstanding over the period/year.

(3) Distributions were paid in cash or reinvested in additional units of the First Trust ETF, or both. Non-cash distributions are reinvested in additional units of the First Trust ETF and subsequently consolidated. Neither the number of units held by the unitholder, nor the net asset per unit of the First Trust ETF change as a result of any non-cash distributions.

(1) Management expense ratio is based on total expenses (excluding commissions and other portfolio transaction costs) for the stated period/year, including the First Trust ETF's proportionate share of the MER of the Underlying Fund in which the First Trust ETF has invested, and is expressed as an annualized percentage of daily average net asset value during the period/year.

(2) The trading expense ratio represents total commissions and other portfolio transaction costs expressed as an annualized percentage of daily average net asset value during the period/year. This includes the First Trust ETF's proportionate share of the commissions of Underlying Fund in which the First Trust ETF has invested.

(3) The First Trust ETF's portfolio turnover rate indicates how actively the First Trust ETF's portfolio advisor manages its portfolio investments. A portfolio turnover rate of 100% is equivalent to the First Trust ETF buying and selling all of the securities in its portfolio once in the course of the period/year. The higher a First Trust ETF's portfolio turnover rate in a period/year, the greater the trading cost payable by the First Trust ETF in the period/year, and the greater the chance of an investor receiving taxable capital gains in the period/year. There is not necessarily a relationship between high turnover rate and the performance of a First Trust ETF.

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Management Fees

The First Trust ETF will pay the Manager a management fee of 0.15% based on the average daily NAV of the First Trust ETF. The management fee, plus applicable taxes including HST, will be accrued daily and paid monthly in arrears. The Manager may, from time to time in its discretion, waive all or a portion of the management fee charged at any given time.

The First Trust ETF will bear the Underlying Fund's management fee of 0.65% per annum on average daily net assets on the First Trust ETF's portfolio assets invested in the Underlying Fund. Accordingly, the management fee cost to unitholders of their investment will be 0.80% per annum of NAV of the First Trust ETF plus applicable taxes.

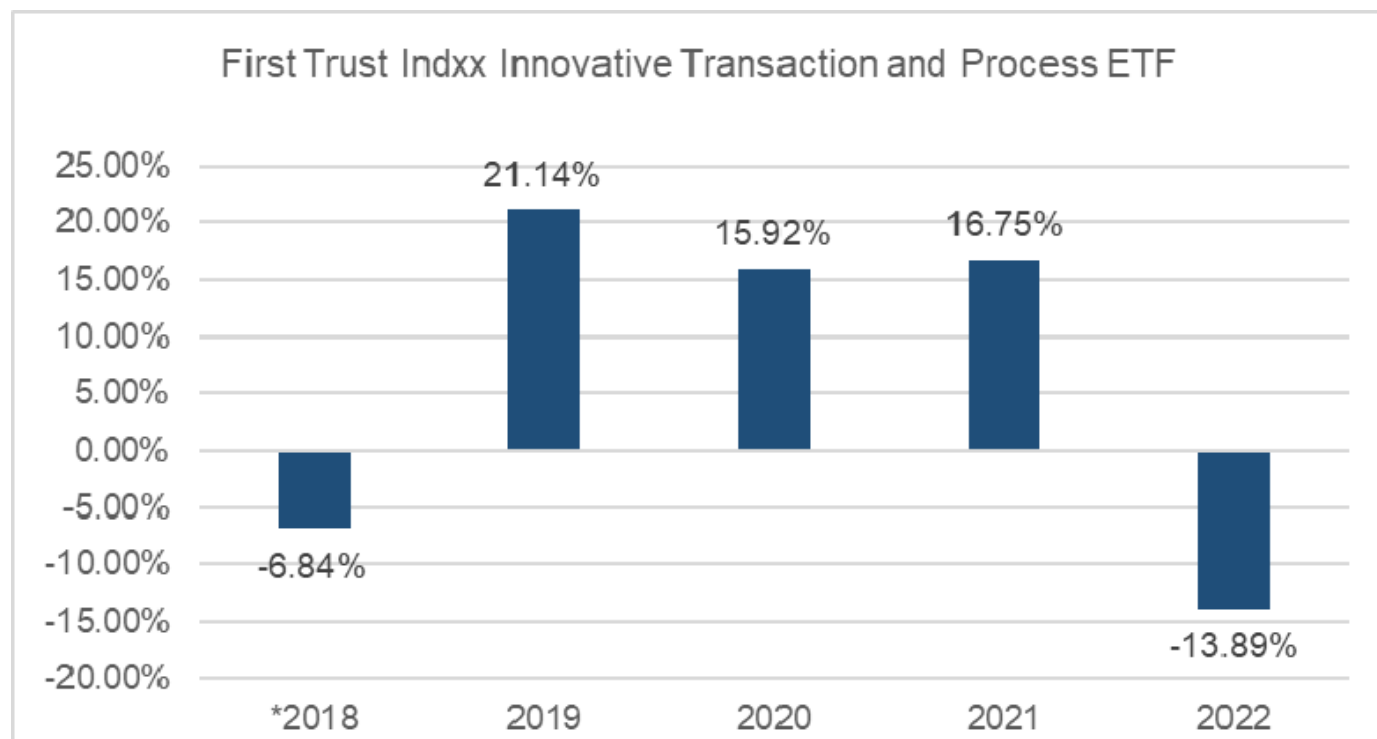
Past Performance

General

The past performance information shown assumes that all distributions made by the First Trust ETF in the period/years shown were reinvested in additional securities of the First Trust ETF.
