# Investment Objective and Strategy

The fundamental investment objective of **First Trust Tactical Bond Index ETF** (the "First Trust ETF") is to replicate, to the extent possible, the performance of the NASDAQ Canadian Preservation CAD TR<sup>SM</sup> (the "Index"), net of expenses.

The investment strategy of the First Trust ETF is to invest in and hold the constituent securities of the Index in the same proportion as they are reflected in the Index or securities intended to replicate the performance of such Index. The First Trust ETF may also hold cash and cash equivalents or other money market instruments to fund current liabilities.

The Index seeks to construct a dynamic fixed income portfolio that provides exposure to several different fixed income asset classes and consists of ETFs.

The Manager may use a sampling methodology in selecting investments for the First Trust ETF. As an alternative or in conjunction with investing in and holding constituent securities, the First Trust ETF may also invest in other securities to obtain exposure to the constituent securities of the applicable Index in a manner that is consistent with the investment objective and investment strategy of the First Trust ETF.

#### Risk

The risks associated with an investment in the First Trust ETF remain as discussed in the First Trust ETF's most recent prospectus. There have been no significant changes during the period that affected the overall level of risk associated with the First Trust ETF.

# **Results of Operations**

### General

The First Trust ETF's net asset value as of December 31, 2020 was \$4,953,788 or \$16.51 per unit. The First Trust ETF's net asset value as of December 31, 2019 was \$10,972,765 or \$18.29 per unit.

For the year ended December 31, 2020, the First Trust ETF paid total cash distributions per unit of \$0.5900. In addition, the First Trust ETF declared cash distributions per unit of \$0.0450 for record date of December 31, 2020 with payment date of January 8, 2021.

#### Investment Performance

For the year ended December 31, 2020, the First Trust ETF returned -6.45% compared to the Index return of -5.87%. Unlike the Index, the First Trust ETF's return is net of fees and expenses.

Most of the underperformance happened in the first two quarters of the year, with March the most severe month. The return for the First Trust ETF in the first quarter of 2020 was -13.60%, while the return for the Index was -13.49%. Performance improved for the First Trust ETF and the Index in the second quarter of 2020, with First Trust ETF returning 3.27% and the Index returning 3.35%. The First Trust ETF and the Index recovered in the second half of the year, with the First Trust ETF returning 4.85% and the Index returning 5.27%

The Index's underperformance in the early half of the year can be mainly attributed to its High Yield exposures. It held two High Yield ETFs, CVD and XHY, with in total about 40% of the portfolio weights at the start of 2020.

For the same reason, the High Yield exposure in Index helped in the risk-on market rally at the second half of the year.

The Index deploys a proprietary quantitative model that has the flexibility to decrease or increase duration and credit risk via a momentum-driven tactical overlay. The current index positions, as suggested by the model, has backed to positions very alike at the beginning of the year: it is slightly in favor of investment graded bonds, with about 60% allocation versus the 40% in high yields. It, however, more inclined to hold long maturity and international (i.e. EM) bonds. This might worth more attention in the near future, given that both dollar and inflation expectation seem approaching the turning points soon.

#### **Recent Developments**

The U.S. Federal Reserve Bank's and U.S. Congress' monetary and fiscal stimulus policies once again have caused the weakening of the dollar and the rising of inflation expectation. What's different from the last crisis in 2008 is that the U.S. is now in a near-zero interest rate environment. The real 10-year yield has already been negative, since

mid-2019. A prolonged period of negative yield is indeed very unimaginable for the U.S. economy. On the other hand, the urgent approval and roll-out of vaccines, and the robust performance of small cap sector stocks, both suggest that the real growth of U.S. economy should be much brighter. The most recent spike of the long-term U.S. Treasury yield is a clear signal that investors turned to focus on the U.S. oriented growth again.

FT Portfolios Canada Co. is the Manager of the First Trust ETF and is a Canadian affiliate of First Trust Advisors L.P., the investment advisor (the "Advisor") of the First Trust ETF.

Pursuant to terms of the declaration of trust of the First Trust ETF, the Manager provides or arranges for all management, administrative and other services required by the First Trust ETF. The Manager receives a management fee from the First Trust ETF. For further details, please see "Management Fees".

The Manager has retained the Advisor to provide certain services to the First Trust ETF pursuant to an investment advisory agreement. The Advisor receives advisory fees from the Manager out of the management fee.

<sup>(2)</sup> Net asset value and distributions are based on the actual number of units outstanding at the relevant time. The increase/decrease from operations is based on the weighted average number of units outstanding over the year.

<sup>(2)</sup> The trading expense ratio represents total commissions and other portfolio transaction costs expressed as an annualized percentage of daily average net asset value during the year. This includes the First Trust ETF's proportionate share of the commissions of any underlying fund in which the First Trust ETF has invested.

<sup>(3)</sup> The First Trust ETF's portfolio turnover rate indicates how actively the First Trust ETF's portfolio advisor manages its portfolio investments. A portfolio turnover rate of 100% is equivalent to the First Trust ETF buying and selling all of the securities in its portfolio once in the course of the period/year. The higher a First Trust ETF's portfolio turnover rate in a year, the greater the trading cost payable by the First Trust ETF in the period/year, and the greater the chance of an investor receiving taxable capital gains in the year. There is not necessarily a relationship between high turnover rate and the performance of a First Trust ETF.

# **Management Fees**

The First Trust ETF will pay the Manager a management fee of 0.50% based on the average daily NAV of the First Trust ETF. The management fee, plus applicable taxes including HST, will be accrued daily and paid monthly in arrears. The Manager may, from time to time in its discretion, waive all or a portion of the management fee charged at any given time.


#### **Past Performance**

#### General

The past performance information shown assumes that all distributions made by the First Trust ETF in the period/years shown were reinvested in additional securities of the First Trust ETF. <sup>\*</sup>Reference Index: The NASDAQ Canadian Preservation Index utilizes IBIS' Quantitative Tactical Fixed Income Rotation model. The Index will invest in Canadian-listed Exchange-Traded Funds covering various segments of the global fixed income market. The selection of assets is determined through a proprietary technology for Relative Strength. The Index will tactically allocate into five TSX-listed ETFs on an equal-weighted basis based upon IBIS' proprietary model to take advantage of short and long term shifts in quality, duration, and geographic risk within fixed income.
