### Investment Objective and Strategy

The fundamental investment objective of **First Trust Morningstar Dividend Leaders ETF (CAD-Hedged)** (the "First Trust ETF") is to replicate, to the extent possible, the performance of an index of U.S. companies that have shown dividend consistency and dividend sustainability, initially the Morningstar® Dividend Leaders Index<sup>SM</sup>.

The Morningstar® Dividend Leaders Index<sup>SM</sup> consist of stocks listed on one of the three major exchanges, NYSE, NYSE Amex or Nasdaq, that have shown dividend consistency and dividend sustainability. Real Estate Investment Trusts (REITs) are not included.

#### Risk

The First Trust ETF provides exposure to its index by investing all or substantially all of its assets in an underlying U.S. index fund known as First Trust Morningstar Dividend Leaders Index Fund (the "Underlying Fund"), which is managed by the First Trust ETF's portfolio advisor.

The risks associated with an investment in the First Trust ETF is discussed in the First Trust ETF's most recent prospectus.

## **Results of Operations**

#### General

The First Trust ETF's net asset value as of June 30, 2024, was \$9,529,674 or \$31.77 per unit. The First Trust ETF's net asset value as of December 31, 2023, was \$9,347,744 or \$30.15 per unit.

For the six-month period ended June 30, 2024, the First Trust ETF paid total cash distributions of \$0.4150 per unit. In addition, the First Trust ETF declared cash distributions of \$0.3500 per unit for record date of June 28, 2024, with payment date of July 8, 2024.

#### Investment Performance

For the six-month period ended June 30, 2024, the First Trust ETF returned 7.17% compared to the S&P 500® Index (CAD-Hedged) (the "benchmark") return of 14.99%. Unlike the benchmark, the First Trust ETF's return is net of fees and expenses.

The First Trust ETF's only holding, the Underlying Fund, held 100 equity securities as of June 30, 2024. The top ten equity holdings for the Underlying Fund accounted for 55.73% of the portfolio within the Underlying Fund.

The Underlying Fund underperformed the benchmark during this year mostly due to an underweight allocation to the Information Technology sector, which was the best-performing sector during the period. Stock selection within Financial also contributed to the underperformance. An underweight position to Consumer Discretionary stocks, which underperformed during the period, mitigated the underperformance.

The Underlying Fund's top five stocks by contribution to return were AbbVie Inc., Verizon Communications Inc., Altria Group, Inc., Philip Morris International Inc., and Chevron Corporation. The Underlying Fund's bottom five stocks by contribution to return were Walgreens Boots Alliance, Inc., New York Community Bancorp, Inc., U.S. Bancorp, CVS Health Corporation, and Gilead Sciences, Inc.

The First Trust's ETF's exposure to the U.S. dollar contributed positively to its absolute performance during the period, as the U.S. dollar appreciated 3.54% against the Canadian dollar from December 29, 2023, to June 28, 2024.

## **Recent Developments**

The S&P 500® Index returned 15.29%, including dividends, in the first half of the year. The U.S. dollar appreciated relative to the Canadian dollar, meaning the index gained 19.64% over the same period measured in Canadian dollars. The gains were concentrated in a few mega-cap companies from the Information Technology, Communication Services, and Consumer Discretionary sectors. NVIDIA, in particular, benefitted from booming demand for its artificial

intelligence (AI) chips, which sent its market capitalization over \$3 trillion, joining Apple and Microsoft. As a result of the AI-driven rally, Information Technology and Communication Services were the best-performing sectors during the period. Materials and Real Estate, cyclical sectors that didn't benefit from the AI rally, were the period's two worst-performing sectors. Real Estate stocks also suffered from particular weakness in the US commercial real estate market. The overall market continued its ascent despite resilient inflation that stayed above 3% throughout the period. Given its resilience, the market continued to lower its expectations for Fed interest rate cuts this year. The market expected as many as six rate cuts to start the year, and halfway through, the Fed has yet to cut rates this year. Consequently. interest rates rose during the period. The 10-year Treasury yield finished the period at 4.40%, well above 3.88% where it began the year. Overall, the S&P 500® Index finished the period trading at a 23.9 P/E multiple with a 1.33% dividend yield, more expensive than 21.5 and 1.49%, respectively, at the end of 2023.

### **Related Party Transactions**

FT Portfolios Canada Co. is the Manager of the First Trust ETF and is a Canadian affiliate of First Trust Advisors L.P., the investment advisor (the "Advisor") of the First Trust ETF.

Pursuant to terms of the declaration of trust of the First Trust ETF, the Manager provides or arranges for all management, administrative and other services required by the First Trust ETF. The Manager receives a management fee from the First Trust ETF. For further details, please see "Management Fees".

The Manager has retained the Advisor to provide certain services to the First Trust ETF pursuant to an investment advisory agreement. The Advisor receives advisory fees from the Manager out of the management fee.

<sup>(3)</sup> The First Trust ETF's portfolio turnover rate indicates how actively the First Trust ETF's portfolio advisor manages its portfolio investments. A portfolio turnover rate of 100% is equivalent to the First Trust ETF buying and selling all of the securities in its portfolio once in the course of the period/year. The higher a First Trust ETF's portfolio turnover rate in a period/year, the greater the trading cost payable by the First Trust ETF in the period/year, and the greater the chance of an investor receiving taxable capital gains in the period/year. There is not necessarily a relationship between high turnover rate and the performance of a First Trust ETF.

### Management Fees

The First Trust ETF will pay the Manager a management fee of 0.15% based on the average daily NAV of the First Trust ETF. The management fee, plus applicable taxes including HST, will be accrued daily and paid monthly in arrears. The Manager may, from time to time in its discretion, waive all or a portion of the management fee charged at any given time.

The First Trust ETF will bear the Underlying Fund's management fee of 0.30% per annum on average daily net assets on the First Trust ETF's portfolio assets invested in the Underlying Fund. Accordingly, the management fee cost to unitholders of their investment will be 0.45% per annum of NAV of the First Trust ETF plus applicable taxes.


#### **Past Performance**

#### General
